### the INFRASTRUCTURE DIVISION

THE INFRASTRUCTURE DIVISION CONSISTS OF THREE UNITS: Engineering, Service Desk, and Telecommunications/Audiovisuals. Infrastructure supports the foundational technology needs of LACERA members and staff members—including a hybrid meeting structure for Board of Trustees meetings, a call center for members, and the essential security framework protecting the organization.

**The Engineering Unit** is charged with the management, support, and maintenance of the core infrastructure, cloud hosted solutions, and vulnerability management solutions.

**The Service Desk Unit** processes incoming requests and incident reports and facilitates assistance for 450+ end users in the organization.

The Telecommunications/Audiovisuals
Unit is responsible for the management of the organization's corporate telecommunications, remote call center, and oversight of the Board of Trustees boardroom meetings that includes a hybrid and livestreamed monthly meeting structure.

THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SPECIALIST I—WINDOWS ENGINEER will report to the Information Technology Specialist II and actively collaborate on a team of eight to manage LACERA's infrastructure. This role serves as the Windows subject matter expert for the organization. Key responsibilities include providing technical support to users across all departments, managing and maintaining Windows end-points and servers, ensuring network stability and efficiency, implementing and maintaining security measures, overseeing data backup and recovery processes, monitoring system performance, maintaining detailed documentation, participating in or leading infrastructure projects, collaborating with other IT teams, and coordinating with external vendors for support and procurement of IT infrastructure components.

The ideal candidate will have extensive experience with Microsoft Azure and a proven track record in migrating missioncritical systems to virtualized environments hosted by laaS solutions. As this is a highly collaborative role, strong project management skills, effective communication with software developers, business solutions teams, system administrators, and telecommunications and audiovisual teams are essential. The candidate must be highly adaptable to the changing landscape of Microsoft environments, with a focus on continuous learning. This role offers an opportunity to make a significant impact on LACERA's IT infrastructure while advancing in a supportive and dynamic environment.

Such experience must include providing leadership for complex network and associated software and hardware in a high-availability environment, including planning, designing, analysis, and overall project management of network related issues.

#### **Special Requirement Information:**

\*Experience at the level of **Data Systems**Coordinator, LACERA, must include coordinating and participating in the work involved in an information and work processing system program or a complex systems project, or reviews and evaluates and evaluates the design and utilization of a variety of systems. This is the lead level.

\*\*Experience at the level of **Data Systems Supervisor I, LACERA**, must include supervising a small staff of analysts engaged in the analysis, design, and implementation of manual and electronic information and work processing systems, or coordinates the systems program.

**Leave Time.** Instead of traditional sick and vacation leave, employees earn 10 days of annual leave per year and may buy up to 20 additional days of annual leave.

Flexible Spending Accounts. Employees may contribute each month tax-free to Health Care (up to \$254) and Dependent Care (up to \$400) Spending Accounts. The County contributes \$100 per month to the Dependent Care Spending Account.

**Rideshare Benefits.** Monthly transit subsidy, pass purchase program, monthly vanpool subsidy, commuter choice subsidy.
